## Spiritual Development

## Social

## Reading Readiness

## Math Readiness

Sorting, classifying, patterning, graphing, numeral recognition, number sense. **Listen to advice and accept instruction, and in the end you will be wise—Proverbs 19:20**

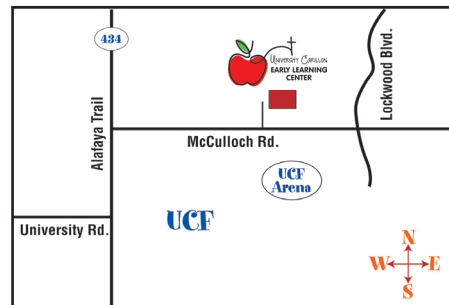
